Safeguarding is everybody's responsibility, so whatever your role in cricket, everyone should understand the importance of keeping children, young people and adults safe in cricket.

With this in mind, we invite everyone to complete the [ECB online Introduction to Safeguarding](#).

Havant Cricket Club is committed to ensuring that everyone involved in cricket has an appropriate level of safeguarding training.

Current training available

- [‘Introduction to Safeguarding’](#) is a new online safeguarding course for ALL individuals involved in cricket. It is a free, 30 minute, introduction providing basic knowledge and advice on creating a safe cricket environment for everyone, recognising signs of abuse and what to do if you have any concerns or if you are approached by anyone with concerns that they may have.
- [Safeguarding Level 2 \(SGL2\)](#) is the new course from the Cricket Regulator Safeguarding Team on behalf of the ECB, which has replaced Safeguarding for Specialist Roles (SSR)
- Robust safeguarding helps to keep our cricket community safe and welcoming. This course will provide the learner with what to look out for and how to respond to concerns. This training should take around 1 hour to complete. The Audience:
 - Coaches or Activators
 - Officials
 - Captains/Vice-Captains
 - Team Managers, Junior Supervisors, Volunteer Coordinators
 - Chairs and Committee Members
 - Club and League Safeguarding Officers
- The Aims and Objectives of the course:
 - Create a safe and inclusive cricket environment
 - Describe what a safeguarding concern is
 - Respond appropriately to concerns
 - Describe how to report and record safeguarding concerns

If your previous safeguarding qualification is due to expire the course will automatically appear on your ECB E-Learning dashboard.
